3. Old Business

a. Meet Formats/Sanction Process

- i. Meet form and sanction form emailed to Steve (<u>classaquatics@aol.com</u>) and Alina (<u>alina@dearmas.co</u>)
 - 1. One of them needs to sign off on the meet form
- Once approved at the committee level all forms are sent on to Judi Divan. Judi will then communicate corrections that need to be made before a sanction number is issued.

v. SCS has their bid meeting in June. Once their calendar is set it will be sent out to Coastal plan meets and it will be voted on in October

b. Novice Meets

c. Closed Invites

- i. Proposal Close Invite meet dates need to be on the Coastal calendar as soon as they are scheduled.
 - 1. Sanctions need to be processed through Coastal Chair same as regular committee meets
 - 2. Closed Invites involving 2 or more Coastal teams must have permission from committee meet host if Invite is within one week of scheduled committee meet.
- ii. Questions/suggestions that have come up by email
 - 1. Why not make a deadline such as 90 days in advance for the calendar and 60 days in advance for the sanction
 - 2. Follow same sanction process as all committee meets
 - 3. Increase number of teams from "2 or more" to "3 or more"
 - 4. If a team were to declare their intention to host a closed invite at the annual bid meeting, would the policy of getting the permission of other adjacent meet hosts apply, or is this meant to regulate the last minute additions?
- iii. We would still divide the committee north and south, just like what is done with regular meet sanctions
- iv. Survey going to go out regarding potential numbers regarding attendance for meets until the end of the year.
- v. Idea Instead of asking permission from meet hosts put it in the hands of the Coastal Committee with input from the host team

d. Use of Committee funds

- i. ASCA Reimbursement Proposal
 - 1. <u>Proposal</u> Coastal money to provide for sending up to 1 coach per team to ASCA, September 6-10, 2023
 - i. \$369.00 early bird registration by May 10. Must be an ASCA member at \$88 per year
 - ii. \$700 hotel (\$154 per night)
 - iii. \$300 food (used per diem for Dallas)
 - iv. \$1369 as a ballpark
 - v. 32 teams @ \$500 per team = \$16,000. Maybe propose up to \$10,000 at \$500 per person
 - b. If people don't take advantage, perhaps other teams could use the leftovers
 - Perhaps there is a deadline to apply for this by May 10 or you only get the money if you pay for ASCA first and then you get a \$500 reimbursement.
 - 2. Survey coaches to find out how many coaches are interested in going
- ii. In person retreat/think tank
- iii. All Star Team/Trip Coastal funds can be used for this
- iv. **Coastal Diversity Camp** Lenin can you put together a rough outline regarding details.

- v. **Backstroke Wedges** 2 sets of 10 backstroke wedges. Looking for ways to get them from one meet to another.
 - 1. Idea provide each team with one to practice with so that swimmers can get used to using them
 - 2. Contact Steve if you would like to use them at your meet
 - 3. Double check and make sure we have all of them straps
 - 4. PVST also has backstroke wedges they are willing to loan out. Contact Coach Emma if you are interested
