
Coaches Roundtable- April 4, 2020

Club Business

• CARES loan/grant info: great resources from Mitch Gold:

Program Overview:

The Paycheck Protection Program is designed to provide a direct incentive for small businesses to keep their workers on payroll by providing each small business a loan up to \$10 million for payroll and certain other expenses. If all employees are kept on payroll for eight weeks, SBA will forgive the portion of the loans used for payroll, rent, mortgage interest, or utilities. Up to 100 percent of the loan is forgivable.

Eligibility:

Businesses – including eligible non-profits, Veterans organizations, Tribal concerns, sole proprietorships, self-employed individuals, and independent contractors described in the Small Business Act – with 500 or fewer employees may apply.

Non-Profits: If your club is a non-profit (c)(3) you can also apply for a SBA SCORE Award (Grant) of \$10,000. Note you must either apply to the loan referenced above, or have an existing SBA loan to be eligible. Also Note this is a 7(a) funded program.
