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### **REPORTS/UPDATES:**

Submitted Reports from Officers, and Committees are posted.

#### **General Chair – Stacy Smith**

- There have been a large number of meetings with the new USA Swimming President.
- There is a focus with the USA Swimming LEAP process
- We have had 102 sanctioned meets to date, which is about 100 less than in the past. There have been 112 Block Parties during this timeframe.

#### **Office and Registration – Nicole Hendry**

- Membership numbers as of March 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - Total 20,250
  - Athletes 18,659 (female 9.05K, male 9.52K)
  - Non-Athletes 1,591
    - Officials 261
    - All other types 1,330
- We are the largest LSC and unfortunately, we have a high number (over 200) of coaches and officials not being in good standing. USA Swimming does alert members to expiring certificates. Red Cross certifications need to be submitted to the office.
- Members not in good standing adversely affect USA Swimming Insurance, not just for their team, but also if they are at a swim meet it puts the meet into jeopardy.
- There is also an issue with 18&over not having completed their ATP. If they don't have their ATP, they are not in good standing.
- Operational Risk offered to help by sending an email out to all coaches with tips especially about the Red Cross water certification requirements.
- Please reach out to the SCS Office if you have any questions with your membership.

#### **Athlete Sr. Chair – Grace Nackers**

- USA Swimming Central and Western Zones will be holding an Athlete Summit July 11<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> at Washington University in St. Louis MO. This is also the same week as June Age Group (JAG). She is looking to have 3-4 SCS Swimmers to attend. Funding for this has already been allocated in the budget.

#### **Executive Director – Steve Roush**

- Currently SCS is involved in a multi-million-dollar lawsuit from a meet. USA Swimming insurance is covering as all in attendance were in good standing.
- Unfortunately, Block Parties do not review if athletes or coaches are in good standing. There have been 85 athletes who were not in good standing that attended Block Parties.
- Provided a status on the LEAP process that we are currently doing. The SCS surveyed its members. His report listed four key areas where the response was below “meeting expectations”.
  - Education (In-Person & Virtual)
  - Membership
  - Strategic Plan
  - Communications
- There was discussion on these areas especially around the Communications, Web Site and Policy & Procedures. Governance has looked at this as group in the past and already had placed it on their agenda.



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- Top Times Award Baquet is scheduled for May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**COMMITTEE REPORT:**

- SCS 2026 Top Times Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> at Noon to 4:00pm at the Embassy Suites Anaheim South Hotel. Our keynote speaker for this year will be Amanda Beard, former SCS swimmer who now coaches at the University of Arizona. Notice has been posted on the SCS website as well as sent to all SCS coaches for verification. Written invitations are being sent out this week for RSVPs. We are anticipating between 400-500 participants this year.
- The 2027 SCS Meet Calendar is currently being finalized by Planning, Senior and Age Group Committees along with time standards and meet formats. Once the calendar is finalized and approved by the SCS Board we will open up the Bid Process and look to finalize the meet selection process no later than early June 2026.
- MEGA LSC Swim Festival continues to move forward with SCS hosting the 2026 Inaugural event in August 2026 at Mission Viejo around the Pan Pacific Championships being hosted by NOVA in Irvine. The dates of the Festival are August 12-16. LSCs committed to this event so far include Indiana, Middle Atlantic, North Carolina, Gulf and SCS. Plans is conduct this competition annually (or bi-annually) around major international level competitions. The focus on this program is more about the experience than just another competition.
- SCS has a new meet sanction application process that incorporates a better system of tracking and accountability. We request that Admin Officials and Meet Referees respond promptly to keep the sanction application moving through the system. It has been recommended that SCS provide some training on this process to our Officials.

- Due to health & safety concerns for sufficient coverage for SCS athletes competing in the Open Water Nationals & Junior Nationals, the SCS club support funding for clubs participating in these competitions will allow for a second coach receiving funds for all teams.
- Block Party Swim Meets are growing in number in SCS. The majority of these meets involve 1 or 2 swim clubs and are conducted as non-OTS Approved meets. As of the end of February SCS has had 112 Block Party Meets since September 1, 2025. There remains serious concerns about the rules and regulations associated with these meets and in some cases whether USA Swimming insurance would be in effect with the fact that many of these meets have unregistered swimmers participating. This could expose the swim clubs to potential large losses. The party line coming from USA Swimming is that bypassing the LSC fees the host clubs are in better position to finance their national team athletes using the funds from the Block Party Meets.
- Following up on this concept of ensuring that all participating athletes and coaches are registered and in good standing at SCS sanctioned meets, it is critical that SCS tighten up the processes involved in pre-meet recons and clearing up the problems prior to the start of the sanctioned competition to ensure that we are not following the same path as the Block Party Meets and exposing the host club, coach and LSC to potential loss of insurance coverage. SCS is working to create a more accountable system to hold the Admins to standards that keep us in compliance. We will bring this plan to the Board at the next meeting in an effort to protect our membership and the assets of the LSC.
- In an effort to keep the SCS Board informed on a pending issue related to the 2026 Summer Age Group Championships at Riverside. The RCC facility is currently closed due to major construction taking place at the facility. The timeline associated with this project is showing that the work is scheduled to be completed by the end of June which would allow for it to be ready ahead of the dates of the SCS SAG meet. RAA will continue to monitor the progress and keep SCS updated.
