Actionable Item(s)

1. Spring Junior Olympics: Change the limit of one relay per team to two (2) per team; Teams must qualify using a hard cut. Teams may have an A and B relay that meet the qualifying Spring Junior Olympic time standard.

Rationale: The Age Group Chair was asked to bring the item of relay limits to the age group committee for discussion. After receiving feedback and a lengthy discussion, the committee recommended increasing the limit to A and B relays for Spring Junior Olympics.
