- Write and document workouts. This includes a dryland regiment partnered with the team's strength training coach.
- Attend competitions
- Serve as a liaison with private and public facilities to ensure continued practice.
- Attend Coaches and Board Meetings
- Take part in team events/philanthropy. The senior athletes started a nonprofit/partnership with the Special Olympics of Los Angeles in 2021. Our athletes play a direct role in coaching the Special Olympic athletes.
