2022 Metro Coach of the year & 2022 Metro Coach Achievement Award

One vote per team. Each team entered will be on the ballot. Each team can assign a coach to represent them. Also, highlight the top two teams in total combined points for each SCS Summer JO. The winner of the coach of the meet for the Metro Summer Festival Meet, the Summer Metro Champs, and the six Metro coaches whose team placed the best at the SCS Summer JO's will be on the ballot. Voting will be done via an email ballot, and winners will be announced during the Sept. Metro meeting. Metro Committee would supply the winning coach with a custom award.

The Metro Coach Achievement Award will be awarded to a Metro Coach that has demonstrated outstanding achievement over the year and or years in coaching excellence within the Metro Committee. Nominations, a simple email vote, and Metro Committee would supply the winning coach with a custom award.

The USA Swimming Open Water Nationals/Junior Nationals were held in Fort Myers, Florida the weekend of April 1-3. Led by the Sandpipers of Nevada, SCS athletes placed in all 8 races. The meet was the qualifying event for our National and Junior National teams and for the World Championships in Budapest Hungary and the Junior Championships in Victoria, Seychelles this summer. Travel funds are now available to swimmers going to the USA Championships.
