	James B. commented relays in the middle is really hard hard on kids. Some coaches expressed they feel it's fine where the relays are placed. Relays placement is  DISCUSSION: the committee has voted to put relays in the middle. An option would be to move the relays to the beginning or end of the meet, or let the teams. Some choices are a) we can either mandate where the relays go, or b) the program chair and the meet teams can decide where to place the relays. Or if it's a dual site meet, both locations will follow the same protocol. The suggestion was made that this seems like a program committee decision not EC decision? Some coaches think it should be left up to the host team. Some parents remove kids from relays when they are trying to qualify. Some teams like to have the option.  MOTION: the decision for the placement of relays within a meet will be decided by the program committee and not the Eastern Committee and if it's a split meet both meets events must identical.
