- b. Overview:

- iii. 2018 requires us to cover the cost of WZ D&I camp and SCSD&I Camp. Makes budget tighter in the even years.

- iv. Oliver suggestion to make an annual SCS D&I Meet that would generate revenue for SCS D&I to offset the even years when the budget is tight. Sarah will talk to the BOD of directors about the feasibility of adding another meet into the SCS meet calendar.
