AGE GROUP COMMITTEE REPORT

The Age Group Committee met on Wednesday, January. 25th from 8:00-9:45 pm and Tuesday, March 7th, from 8:15-9:00 pm.

The Age Group Committee has one BoD Proposal:

Swimmers will be allowed to enter Bonus Events in the following situations:

- Swimmers who qualify for 1 events can swim two bonus events for a total of 3 events
- Swimmers who qualify for 2 events can swim one bonus event for a total of 3 events
- Swimmers who qualify for 3 events can swim one bonus event for a total of 4 events

The Bonus Events Rule will be in place for JAG/WAG and Summer Age Group Championships.

- Bonus events may only be entered in races 200 or shorter
- All Bonus events must be National BB or faster
- If the swimmer qualifies for either the 800 free (1000 free) or the 1500 free (1650 free), they may swim the other distance as a bonus event

The Age Group Committee has gotten BoD approval for the following:

- We have identified a need to fill the third location for Summer Age Group Championships. This has been approved by the BoD.
- We have finalized the Mount SAC site run by BREA as that third option. This has been approved by the BoD.
- We have agreed to promote the Age Group Elite Championships meet in August at swim meets, email, and word of mouth.

The Age Group Committee has several recommendations for BoD approval:

- We recommend continuing the SCS All Star Festival in Las Vegas, NV for 2024 (with the intention of trying to bring the meet to UNLV).
- We have agreed to continue to grow the Age Group Coaching Clinic in Las Vegas, NV for 2024.
- We recommend hosting the Pac Coast Meet in 2024 at East LA
- We recommend a return to Team Travel for the Pac Coast Meet in 2024, beginning with a practice session on Friday, January 5, 2024 and the meet Saturday afternoon, January 6, 2024 through Sunday morning January 7, 2024.

- We have agreed to move the SCS All Star Festival Meet to later in January (preferably January 26-28th if we can work out the schedule with UNLV).
- No sanctioned meet should be allowed during the Festival/Clinic weekend.

The Age Group Committee is also close to producing a document for the Geo Committees to use to promote Novice Meets

- Potential Name for the meets: BB Max Meets
- Menu of formats for clubs to choose
- Officiating Options for sanctioned versus unsanctioned meets
- Teaching opportunities for Officials, Coaches, and Swimmers
- Tips to reduce costs through running meets during practice times, limiting the number of events, or controlling number of entries
- Using Intrasquad meets, Dual Meets, Tri Meets, and Larger Novice Meets for the Committee

2023 LEAP Certification Process – LSC Evaluation and Achievement Program

USA Swimming has notified SCS that we are due for our LEAP Certification in 2023. The deadline for submission is June 30, 2023. Steve Roush along with Carol Cracchiolo may be reaching out to various members to obtain documents and/or sites where materials can be found as part of the certification process. The three major areas involved in the process are: 1) Governance: Structure and Direction of the LSC, 2) Programming: Services provided for the members, and 3) Communications: Systems to communicate with members. Thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter.

SCS Strategic Planning Update

SCS held a Strategic Planning session (in-person & virtually) on February 5th at the La Mirada Aquatic Center. The first part of the planning session focused on updating the SCS Mission and Vision Statements and is being handled by the SCS Governance Committee. The second part of the meeting focused on identifying key areas that SCS should concentrate on in the short-term (next 12-18 months). Topics were solicited from all the Board prior to the meeting and we had categories selected from the various submitted areas. The Top 4 Categories (for SCS short-term focus) as voted on by the meeting participants were: 1) Financial, 2) Build Membership, 3) Performance, and 4) Communication. The other categories that were listed and deemed more longer-term priorities were Meet Formats, Governance, Outreach, Age Group Swimming, Elite Programs/Services, and Coach Education.

It is important that SCS keep the momentum going on this initiative of developing the SCS Strategic Plan to allow for the organization to create a plan that will serve as a roadmap for SCS Staff, SCS Board, SCS Committees and the SCS Membership to understand the goals and objectives of the organization for the future. This is a required element for the LEAP Certification but is also critical for areas such as fundraising, sponsorships, governing strategically, and measuring/evaluating progress of the organization.

I plan to have a short PowerPoint presentation to show during the March 15th SCS Board Meeting to summarize the outcome of the first planning meeting and hopefully set a date for the next meeting in early to mid-April for the next phase of planning.

USA Swimming Zoom Licenses

The current program for Zoom licenses through USA Swimming will be discontinued as of April 1, 2023. SCS is looking into other options for our needs for video conferencing among the SCS Office, Board, Committees and Swim Clubs. An update can be given during the March 15 SCS Board Zoom meeting since the shutdown of the account through USA Swimming is only two weeks away. The three platforms that are suitable for the type of utilization being done by SCS are Zoom, Microsoft Teams and Google Meet. All three platforms are HIPAA-compliant so security is not an issue between the platforms. Zoom is a fee-based license (prices vary based on number of accounts under the license) while Team and Google Meet are included in the Office365 and G Suite licenses for free with non-profit organizations.

Communication Platforms

SCS is working to revamp our communication platforms that include the SCS website, Facebook page, Instagram and Constant Contact. We are exploring more effective ways to communicate news and alerts to our membership. Several meetings have taken place on the website and we are working on a re-design in the coming weeks. As part of that new design we are planning to integrate our social media onto the website to help build our followers.

Potential Aquatic Facility Project

SCS staff is working with Total Aquatic Programming and Counsilman-Hunsaker on proposals to assist with developing a plan regarding the possible aquatic center project at Santa Monica Airport. Once we have received proposal with costs for assisting in the design and pitch we will come back to the SCS Board for budget approval to move forward with the project. At that point we would ask to create a small task force to work with Steve on this project.

Fed funds terminal rate now between 5.50-5.75%. Silicon Valley Bank insolvency last week was the first major bank to be seized by the FDIC since 2008. The portfolio, nonetheless, is still about \$3.8MM as of 3/10/23.

 - Electronics One way transmission electronics are allowed to be worn by the swimmer (one way transmission electronic to transmit to their coach for data collection to be

reviewed later - information cannot be transmitted from the Coach back to the Swimmer)

 USA Swimming Rule USA Swimming Rule 101.4.2 (pp 24) – To Comply with World Aquatics SW6.3

Stroke — The swimmer shall push off on his back and continue swimming on the back throughout the race. Some part of the swimmer must break the surface of the water throughout the race, except it is permissible for the swimmer to be completely submerged during the turn and for a distance of not more than 15 meters (16.4 yards) after the start and after each turn. By that point, the head must have broken the surface of the water. <u>Additionally, once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the 5-</u> <u>meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5 yard mark (short course yards)</u> <u>immediately prior to reaching the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged prior</u> to the touch.

Starting immediately, we are training all officials to use the command "take your marks". This appears in the rulebook in several places. The following list is exhaustive.

USA Swimming requires the use of certified meet officials when conducting sanctioned swim meets. USA Swimming has established minimum standards for certifying meet officials. The Southern California Swimming (SCS) Officials' Committee is charged with establishing certification criteria and administering the certification process. Southern California Swimming is proud to meet or exceed those minimum standards when certifying meet officials.

Administrative Officials

Southern California Swimming certifies meet officials in the following positions:

The goal of the minimum standards for the certification of officials is to set criteria that when applied will accomplish the following: (paraphrased from the USA Swimming Minimum Standards Mission Statement).

- Assure a clear and consistent knowledge of the rules and their application.
- Provide sufficient time in training to assure familiarity with all levels of competition.
- Provide opportunity to work on the deck and advance through the certification process.
- Allow automatic acceptance at the <u>Stroke & Turn</u> level between all LSCs meeting the USA Swimming Minimum Standards Guidelines.
- Ensure professionalism in all aspects of the word "team" while in attendance at a swim event both on and off the deck.

Clinic Attendance Policy:

Officials are required to attend a Southern California Swimming Officials' clinic each year as part of the certification / recertification requirements. These clinics are held at least once a year, typically the first weekend in October. At times a remote/virtual clinic may be offered for Stroke and Turn, Starter, Deck Referee or Administrative certified officials. If offered, attendance at this clinic satisfies the clinic requirement for certification. SCS does understand that at times officials may have conflicts with the clinic date and may not be able to attend the clinic. To allow for this the following attendance policy had been adopted by the SCS Officials' Committee and endorsed by the SCS Board of Directors.

An SCS official is allowed to miss the SCS clinic once in a four-year period. If a clinic is missed, the official must take the USA-Swimming online test that is of the level appropriate to his/her highest certification. If an official does not attend the required number of clinics or fails to take the USA-S test after missing two clinics in a row, his/her certification level may be decreased by one level. An official may regain their certification by successfully passing the USA-S test for that level certification and attending the next available SCS officials' clinic.

Officials' Certifications

<u>General Requirements for certification</u>: (duties include learning USA Swimming stroke and turn rules, the official interpretations of them and how to apply the rules in a swim meet.)

- If not noted in specific requirements, the minimum age is 18 years old.
- Must be a non-athlete member of USA Swimming (check the official's box on the registration form).
- Pass USA Swimming background check, take the online Athlete Protection Training (APT) and California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act (CANRA).
- ALL officials must complete concussion and Sudden Cardiac Arrest training (instructions listed on the SCS website in the Officials section).
- Obtain an SCS official's uniform.
- Deck Officials are also required to provide a family channel radio and headset capable of setting privacy channels.
- Attend a SCS Officials' clinic. An official may be certified prior to clinic attendance but must attend the next available SCS clinic.
- The sessions referred to in the guidelines should be of duration to assure sufficient time to observe a significant number of swimmers and should contain a complete schedule of events to provide the opportunity to observe all strokes.
- Any training sessions worked in a position prior to satisfying the minimum time in position prerequisite will not count towards meeting the certification requirements for advancement.
- The 2 different committee requirements may be fulfilled by a referee from a different committee traveling to the apprentices committee.
- To maintain integrity of the system, evaluations may not be performed by family members or close relations.
- Completion of the minimum standards does not guarantee automatic advancement to a higher-level certification.

Modifications to Officials certifications will be reviewed by the Officials Committee and approved by the Officials Chair(s) before advancement / change takes effect. Upon approval the Officials Chairperson will update the Officials LSC Certification in OTS.

SCS Deck Officials' Certifications

PLEASE NOTE: The training requirements for advancement listed below are <u>minimum</u> <u>standards only</u>.

<u>Stroke and Turn: ST</u> (duties include the observation of swimming competition to ensure the technical rules of USA Swimming are followed. The stroke and turn official will report any observation of an infraction to the Deck Referee, who will accept or decline the disqualification.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 18 years old).
- Pass USA Online Swimming Timer and Stroke and Turn officials' tests with a score of 80% or better.
- Apprentice with two different Meet Referees for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 separate meets & 2 different committees). During the first 8 sessions, the candidate is considered an apprentice and cannot make unassisted infraction calls.
- Pass evaluation by a Meet Referee. During evaluation the candidate will initiate calls to be verified by the referee or designee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Stroke and Turn for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 separate meets) in the calendar year.

<u>Stroke and Turn Observed Status: ST-OS</u> (duties include the observation of High School & college, USA Swimming observed swimming competition to ensure the technical rules of USA Swimming are followed. The stroke and turn official will report any observation of an infraction to the Deck Referee, who will accept or decline the disqualification.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 18 years old).
- Must be a certified High School Official for this certification.
- Pass USA Online Swimming Timer and Stroke and Turn officials' tests with a score of 80% or better.
- Work 4 sessions at S&T at a USA sanctioned meet (USA min Requirement).
- Apply for ST-OS (observed status) with the SCS Officials Committee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Stroke and Turn for a minimum of 2 sessions in the calendar year at a USA sanctioned meet (USA min Requirement).

<u>Starter: SR</u> (The duties include ensuring the fair and equitable start of races).

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Pass USA Swimming Online Starter test with a score of 80% or better.
- Before training for Certified Starter can begin, the official must have worked as a Certified Stroke & Turn for a minimum of 6 months to include 12 sessions.
- Apprentice as a Starter for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 separate meets and in 2 different committees) under the supervision of at least two different trainers in two different committees and pass an evaluation by a Senior Meet Referee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Starter for a minimum of 8 sessions (3 separate meets) in the calendar year.

Deck Referee: DR (The duties include the observation of all aspects of the competition. The deck referee ensures that all athletes are present for each heat and will observe the start of each race while he/she is on duty and confirm any false starts. The deck referee will also receive any information concerning disqualifications and accept or reject the disqualification.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 18 years old).
- Pass USA Swimming online referee tests.
- **Before training for Certified Deck Ref** can begin, officials must have worked as a Certified Stroke and Turn Official for a minimum of 1 year to include 16 sessions under the supervision of at least two different Meet Referees.
- Apprentice as a Deck Referee for a minimum of 16 sessions (4 separate meets & 2 different committees) under the supervision of at least two different Meet Referees.

• Pass evaluation by a Senior Referee or Certified Deck Referee Evaluator. Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Deck Referee for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 separate meets) in the calendar year.

<u>Meet Referee (Timed Finals): MR (</u>duties include the overall supervision of the swimming competition at Timed Finals meets. The meet referee will delegate job duties as required and make any decisions concerning the competition. As required, the Meet Referee will provide mentoring and evaluations of Stroke and Turn officials and give constructive feedback to officials.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 21 years old).
- Pass USA Swimming Online referee and admin referee tests.
- Be familiar with the positions of Automatic Timing Equipment Operator, Announcer, Timer, Meet Marshall, and Administrative Official procedures.
- Before training for Certified Meet Referee (Timed Finals) can begin, the official must have worked as a Certified Deck Referee for a minimum of one year to include 16 sessions in a calendar year.
- Apprentice as a Meet Referee for a minimum of 18 sessions (4 different meets & 2 different committees) under the supervision of at least two different Senior Meet Referees.
- Must have a working knowledge of OTS.
- Pass evaluation by a Senior Meet Referee and Senior Admin Referee or two Senior Meet Referees.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Meet Referee for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 different meets) in the calendar year.

<u>Meet Referee (Heats and Finals): MR-HF (</u>duties include the overall supervision of the swimming competition at Heats and Finals meets. The Meet Referee will delegate job duties as required and make any decisions concerning the competition. As required the Meet Referee will provide evaluations of officials and give constructive feedback to officials.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 21 years old).
- Before training for Certified Meet Referee (Heats and Finals) can begin, the official must have worked as a certified Meet Referee (Timed Finals Meets) for a minimum of 2 years to include 48 sessions.
- Must be certified as an Administrative Official and be familiar with Heats & Finals administrative procedures.
- Must be signed off by a Heats & Finals Admin Referee that the Official has completed their training and understands the Heats & Finals administration procedures.
- Work as an apprentice Meet Referee at Heats and Finals Meets for a minimum of 18 sessions (3 different meets & 2 different locations) under the supervision of at least two different Heats & Finals Meet Referees.

• Pass evaluation by two Senior Referees, or a Senior Referee and Senior Admin Referee. Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Meet Referee (Timed Finals) for a minimum of 6 sessions (2 separate meets) in the calendar year.
- Work at Heats & Finals meets for a minimum of 6 sessions in the calendar year.

Evaluator: MR-SR (A Senior official is an ambassador of the sport and should always lead by example. The Senior Referee will evaluate candidates for certification and provide constructive feedback to all SCS officials.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification. (Must be 21 years old).
- Must have worked as a certified Meet Referee (Heats & Finals Meets) for a minimum of 5 years to include 50 sessions.
- Upon the recommendation of a Senior Referee and Senior Admin Referee and with the approval of the SCS Officials' Committee Chairman, a Meet Referee Heats and Finals Meets MR-HF may be advanced to a Senior Referee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as a Meet Referee for a minimum of 6 sessions (2 different meets) in the calendar year.
- Demonstrate outstanding mentoring and evaluation skills.

SCS Administrative Officials

PLEASE NOTE: The training requirements for advancement listed below are <u>minimum</u> standards <u>only</u>. Completion of the minimum standards does not guarantee automatic promotion to a higher-level certification.

A<u>utomatic Timing Equipment Operator (CTS): TO (</u>duties include the setup, running and troubleshooting of automatic timing equipment.)

- Minimum age is 15 years old.
- Apprentice with a qualified operator for 8 sessions (2 meets), one meet must be using touch pads. It is recommended that training be performed using a Colorado Timing system or a Daktronics timing system.
- Pass evaluation by a Meet Referee or Admin Referee. Re-certification:
- Work as a Timing System Operator for a minimum of 6 sessions in the calendar year.

<u>Clerk Of Course: CC</u> (Duties include all aspects of admin including knowledge of Hy Tek Meet Manager Program and the manual seeding procedure.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (Must be 18 years old).
- Pass USA Swimming Online Timer, Timing Judge and Clerk of Course tests with a score of 80% or better.
- Apprentice with an Admin Official for a minimum of 8 sessions (at least 2 separate meets) or by recommendation of a Senior Admin Referee and Senior Referee.
- Pass evaluation by an Administrative Referee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as Clerk Of Course for a minimum of 3 sessions in the calendar year.

<u>Administrative Official: AO</u> (May Work an Intrasquad Meet, Dual, & Timed Finals Meets under 300 swimmers without an Admin Referee. [Duties include all aspects of admin including knowledge of Hy-Tek Meet Manager Program])

- Meet all general requirements for certification (Must be 18 years old).
- Pass USA Swimming Online Timer, Timing Judge and Clerk of Course, and Admin Referee tests with a score of 80% or better.
- Apprentice with two different Admin Referees for a minimum of 16 sessions (at least 4 separate meets & 2 different committees).
- Pass evaluation by an Administrative Referee (Heats & Finals). Re-certification:
- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as an Administrative Official a minimum of 12 sessions (3 different meets) in the calendar year.

Administrative Referee (Timed Finals): AR (duties include the supervision of all administrative operations of timed finals meets, including pre-meet problem resolution, Clerk of Course, Timing, and Result generation, must have interface with parents and coaching staff. PLEASE NOTE: Administrative Referee may act as the Meet Referee in a Timed Final Meet in case of an emergency or the absence of a Meet Referee if a Certified Deck Referee is also present, if approved by the Officials Committee.)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 21 years old).
- Pass the USA Swimming Online Administrative Referee test with a score of 80% or better.
- Must be a certified Administrative Official for a minimum of one year to include 16 sessions in a calendar year.
- Apprentice as an Administrative Official for a minimum of 18 sessions (4 different meets & 2 different committees) under the supervision of at least two different Administrative Meet Referees.
- Must be certified as a Stroke & Turn Official.
- Pass an evaluation by a Senior Admin Referee or Senior Meet referee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as an Admin Referee or Admin official for a minimum of 12 sessions (3 different meets) in the calendar year.

Administrative Referee (Heats & Finals): AR-HF (duties include the supervision of all administrative operations of heats and finals meets, including pre-meet problem resolution, Clerk of Course, Timing, and Result generation. Must be able to act as the Meet Referee in case of an emergency or the absence of a Meet Referee)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 21 years old).
- Must have worked as a certified Administrative Referee for a minimum of 2 years to include 48 sessions.
- Apprentice with at least two (2) certified Administrative Referee (Heats and Finals) for a minimum of 18 sessions (3 different meets & 2 different locations).

• Pass evaluation by a certified Senior Admin Referee and a Senior Meet Referee. Re-certification:

• Meet all general requirements for certification.

- Work as a Administrative Meet Referee (Timed Finals) for a minimum of 6 sessions (2 separate meets) in the calendar year.
- Work at Heats & Finals meets for a minimum of 6 sessions in the calendar year.

<u>Senior Administrative Referee AR-SR</u> (Senior officials must be leaders of the sport and are responsible for the mentoring and evaluation of other officials. A senior official is an ambassador of the sport and should always lead by example. Must be able to act as the Meet Referee in case of an emergency or the absence of a Meet Referee)

- Meet all general requirements for certification (must be 21 years old).
- Must have worked as a certified Admin Referee (Heats & Finals Meets) for a minimum of 5 years to include 50 sessions.
- Upon the recommendation of a Senior Admin Referee and a Senior Meet Referee and with the approval of the SCS Officials' Chairperson, an Admin Referee (Heats and Finals) may be promoted to a Senior Admin Referee.

Re-certification:

- Meet all general requirements for certification.
- Work as an Administrative Meet Referee for a minimum of 6 sessions (2 different meets) in the calendar year.
- Demonstrate outstanding mentoring and evaluation skills.

SCS Officials Returning After a Prolonged Absence (does not apply to an official who continues to officiate in another LSC):

PLEASE NOTE: The training requirements listed below for officials returning from a prolonged absence are <u>minimum standards only</u>. Completion of the minimum standards does not guarantee automatic promotion to a certification level previously held by an official.

Less Than Two Years:

- The Official must take all USA-S tests starting with Stroke & Turn up to the level official was previously certified.
- The Official must work as an apprentice at the highest certification level previously held for at least one meet (4 sessions).
- Pass evaluation at their highest level by Senior Meet Referee or a Certified Evaluator for the level.

Three-Five Years:

- The Official must take all USA-S tests starting with Stroke & Turn up to the level official was previously certified.
- The Official must work as an apprentice starting with Stroke & Turn up to the level of certification previously held for at least two meets (8 sessions).
- Pass evaluation at their highest level by Senior Meet Referee or a Certified Evaluator for the level.

More Than Five Years

- Officials must take all USA-S tests starting with Stroke & Turn up to the level official was previously certified.
- Officials must work as an apprentice starting with Stroke & Turn up to the level of certification previously held for at least one meet (4 sessions) per level of certification.
 - For example: if the official was a Meet Ref before leaving, he/she will have to work one

meet (four sessions) as a Stroke & Turn, one meet (four sessions) as a Deck Ref/Starter, etc.

• Pass evaluation at their highest level by Senior Meet Referee or a Certified Evaluator for the level.

Non-SCS Officials' Training:

PLEASE NOTE: The training requirements listed below for officials are <u>minimum standards</u> <u>only</u>. Completion of the minimum standards does not guarantee automatic promotion to a certification level previously held by an official.

Certification from Another LSC:

Officials moving to Southern California and wishing to continue working as a swimming official within SCS will be able to be certified up to Starter (depending on where they were in their previous LSC) after working at least one meet (4 sessions) and pass evaluation by a Senior Meet Referee/Evaluator.

Certification From a High School or College Officials Organization:

A High School or College only officials may be certified no higher than a USA Stroke & Turn Official after working one USA swim meet (4 sessions) and passing the USA S/T Test. From that point the official will be required to follow all certification procedures outlined in this document.

Greetings LSC General Chairs, Admin Chairs, LSC Treasurers, LSC Office Staff and LSC Club Zoom license holders,

During the COVID-19 pandemic, USA Swimming offered discounted Zoom licenses for LSCs and clubs to take advantage of. Since the beginning of the pandemic three years ago, you have continued to thrive in and out of the pool.

While most of our members can meet in person, the necessity of Zoom licenses has ceased, and therefore, USA Swimming will not continue to offer this program past April 1, 2023. Please see below for further information on account closings and other resources to take advantage of if you would like to continue utilizing videoconferencing.

The current Zoom licenses under the USA Swimming account are valid until April 1. After this date you will no longer have a Zoom license within the USA Swimming Zoom account, or access to the archives contained within the account. If you wish to save anything contained in the account, you must access and download prior to April 1. All accounts will be unlinked from the USA Swimming Zoom account on April 2. Please note, you will still have a Zoom account, just not a full license.

We know some LSCs and clubs have used their accounts extensively, so we have gathered some alternatives for consideration:

- 1. Clubs or LSCs can re-establish a Zoom license on their own in ZOOM;
- 2. Goggle offers a similar platform for free to Non-Profit Organizations in Google Meet Up; and
- 3. Microsoft offers a similar tool in Microsoft Teams Meetings. It is free for Non-Profit Organizations and, we believe, the easiest transition for those who already utilize the Microsoft platform.

The Club Support Qualifying meets and Funding Levels shall be determined by the Senior Committee and approved by the Board of Directors annually in February, for the upcoming season. To qualify for Club Support athletes must participate in one of three acceptable types of meets:

- 1. US-sanctioned National championship or Selection Meet (other than Olympic Trials), World Trials, US Open, US National Championship, US Jr Nationals, Futures.
- 2. USA Pro event sanctioned by the National body (currently the TYR Pro series)
- 3. Any FINA-recognized event appearing on the FINA Calendar as described in the FINA Constitution section C 14.5 (includes World Cup events, LEN Sanctioned events, most national championship meets for other countries, and many high-end international invitationals, (i.e., Mel Zajac, The Maccabiah Games, and many high-end domestic invitationals like Santa Clara)
- 4. Separate Club Support funding is provided when the 10K Open Water Championship is held separately from National Championship and/or When a Trials Class meet is offered in addition to summer Nationals or Open, Summer Junior Nationals, and summer Futures.
- 5. Swimmers shall be eligible for additional support for any unique Trials event, as scheduled by the National body if said event is held as a separate meet between the Fall and Summer National meets. Club Support funding for the unique Trials event will be in addition to support earned for the Fall and Summer National events.

The funding levels shall be determined by the Senior Committee and based on geographic location and the duration of the meet, using the following formulas:

- US Open, Nationals, and Trials (not including Olympic Trials) \$200 for each day of the meet AND \$700 airfare if east of the Mississippi, \$500.00 airfare if west of the Mississippi (but requiring air transportation), and zero transportation allotment for all local national events.
- Juniors \$100 for each day of the meet. And \$700 airfare if east of the Mississippi, \$500.00 airfare if west of the Mississippi (but requiring air transportation), and zero transportation allotment for all local national events.
- 3. Futures a flat rate \$250 per athlete.
- 4.
