Meeting Called to Order: 7:33 PM

Robin welcomed the attendees to the meeting. It was noted that the March 10, 2021 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved by the Committee via email and have been posted to the SCS website.

COMPETITION:

- 1. Debrief and discussion regarding the USA Swimming OW Nationals/Jr Nationals held April 16th to 18th in Ft. Myers, FL. Those who attended the meet noted the rough water conditions in the Gulf and last minute changes made to the schedule, race courses, and feeding stations. Everyone was very proud of all of the SCS Athletes, Coaches, and Clubs who participated. Robin will submit some articles for posting to the SCS website with the meet results and recognize those who qualified for USA Swimming National/Jr National OW Teams.
- 2. The Swim to Tokyo Special Event currently has 153 entries from around our LSC. Interim results will be posted shortly. Robin requested that Committee members remind their Geographic Committees that the Event is ongoing and entries continue to be accepted. All Athletes entered as of April 30th will receive a special prize.
- 3. SCS OW Calendar was discussed. Local authorities and venues are still not allowing hosts to schedule open water meets or submit special event permit applications. Priority will be to try to schedule SCS OW JOs sometime in the fall, preferably prior to the WZ OW Champs in Sep.
- 4. The Combined USA Swimming OW Nationals/Jr Nationals scheduled for October in Henderson, Nevada will be a qualifying event for National/Jr National OW Team selections. An Open Water Festival is being planned for the dates immediately following the OW Nationals meet and will include additional race distances and age groups.

EDUCATION:

1. Committee discussed the possibility of scheduling smaller open water clinics in conjunction with open water meets. This might be easier to implement based on all of the continuing safety requirements and scheduling limitations as venues start to re-open for the summer. It would also offer an educational opportunity for those who are present including athletes, parents, and officials. Committee will think about feasibility of this when open water meets are able to be scheduled and confirmed moving forward.

SUPPORT:

1. OW Officials are encouraged to take the updated exam on the new rules when the online system opens back up on May 1st. Paul mentioned that shared training and virtual clinics are being discussed and planned to include all open water officials from across the US.

OTHER:

- 1. Club Support amounts for Open Water approved at the recent BOD Meeting include: \$1000 for OW Nationals and \$700 for Junior OW Nationals. It was noted that there are two OW Nationals Meets in 2021. Both are combined Nationals/Jr Nationals and there are separate qualifying criteria for the USA Swimming National/Jr National OW Teams at each meet.
- 2. SCS Committee Budgets for 2022 will be initially estimated as 75% of the 2019 approved budget numbers to start discussions.
- 3. Start time for May 12th meeting was discussed given the changing schedules for everyone. We will try a mid-day start time.
