RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS Meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. (See 2024

SCS Swim Guide). Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on October 19, 2024. All coaches and officials on deck must

complete the CDC or NFHS Concussion course, CAT and CANRA.

RECORDING DEVICES

The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, IS NOT PERMITTED in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not & MEDIA NOTICE:

permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. The meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web

casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

DECK CHANGES: Deck changes are prohibited.

Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming

sanctioned or approved competition. "Tech" suits with bonded seams, kinetic tape, or meshed seams are not permitted at this meet for 12-Un Swimmers.

RACING START Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in

performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance

with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: OPEN TO ATHLETES WHO ARE 2024 or 2025 USA Swimming members. Athletes must be members of the Orange Committee to be eligible for entry into

this meet. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. NO late or deck registration will be accepted. All athletes 18 years or older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING prior to the start of the meet.

Club Transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached but is responsible for

completing the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.

SUBMITTED

Times submitted must be **BEST RECORDED TIMES** short course or long course from this or preceding swim season (NO WORK OUT TIMES. After entries close, TIMES:

non-conforming times will be converted by meet admin for seeding purposes only. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times.

Discrepancy in the submitted times can lead to disciplinary action.

RIBBONS: INDIVIDUAL EVENTS 1st thru 6th, RELAYS 1st thru 3rd AWARDS:

\$6.00 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, plus \$15.50 SURCHARGE per swimmer must accompany each individual entry. Relays are \$10.00 per relay team entered

and are due and payable on deck at the meet. Outreach athletes are \$15.00 flat fee for the meet. Teams must provide proof of outreach athletes status by including a copy of their team roster when submitting entries. E-mail entry (entry.zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline.
