POOL: EL TORO HIGH SCHOOL, 25255 TOLEDO WAY, LAKE FOREST, CA. From the North: POOL:

COURSE: EL TORO HIGH SCHOOL POOL is an outdoor 50 meter pool with ten (10) swimming lanes and ample warm-up space. This competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 ( C ) on file with USA Swimming. Pool Depth Measurements at Start and Turn Ends Lane 1 = 8' 6" slopes to Lane 10 = 8'

WARM UP RULES: USA Swimming warm-up policies will be enforced by USA Swimming Officials. Swimmers warming up or down before, during, or after this swim meet must be under the

direct supervision of a USA Swimming member coach. There will be NO DIVING into the pool during these times except into the designated sprint lane(s). WARM-UP

RULES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND POSTED. All swimmers must use 3-point, slide in entries into the pool for warm up, no jumping or diving in.

MEET REFEREF: Richard Davis shall be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be made directly to Richard.e.davis@gte.net.

RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS Meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. (See 2019 SCS Swim Guide). Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed,

swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers in the first four events of each session must check in THIRTY MINUTES prior to the start of the session. Swimmers entering OPEN events must be 11 or older and have achieved the stated time standard. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group

as determined by their age on July 5, 2019. All coaches on deck must complete the CDC of NFHS Concussion course.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Swimmers may swim a maximum of THREE (3) Individual events per day. Entries will be limited to meet the "4 Hour" rule for the 5-12 sessions. Each team is asked to 7-8 year old swimmers may swim in 5-8 or 7-10 events but not a combination. 7-10 swimmers entering the 400 Meter Freestyle must enter with an achieved 200 Meter Freestyle time that meets the stated minimum time standard. The 400 Meter IM, 400, 800 and 1500 Meter Freestyle events will be swum alternating girls and boys. Swimmers in the 400, 800 and 1500 Meter Freestyle and 400 Meter IM are requested to provide timers for three heats and their own lap counters. Relays

will be swum time permitting. ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM FASTEST TO SLOWEST.

**RECORDING DEVICES &** MEDIA NOTICE:

The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms)

any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming

sanctioned or approved competition. "Tech" Suits are not permitted at this meet.

**DECK CHANGES:** Deck Changes are prohibited.

RACING START **CERTIFICATION:** 

Any swimmer entered in the met unaccompanied by a USA Swimming Coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or

the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: OPEN TO ATHLETES WHO ARE 2019 USA SWIMMING REGISTERED. SCS athletes must be members of the Orange Committee. NO ON-DECK

ENTRIES. Registration applications must be received by Wednesday, June 26, 2019 by the meet processor, administrative referee or SCS office. Late application will be considered "on deck" subject to penalties in SCS Swim Guide, part One, III, B. In SCS age group meets, swimmers 18 & younger must

provide birth dates prior to competition.

CHANGE OF AFFILIATION:

Before the meet, a swimmer may change affiliation by submitting a CLUB TRANSFER form and the appropriate fee to the Swim Office. At the meet, a

swimmer may UNATTACH by notifying the Administrative Referee in writing and paying the appropriate fee. A swimmer may not attach at the meet.

SUBMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be **BEST RECORDED TIMES** short course or long course from this or preceding swim season (NO WORK OUT TIMES). Coaches

and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Discrepancy in the submitted times can lead to disciplinary action.

**QUALIFYING TIMES:** Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time but is otherwise qualified, he/she may enter

the meet at the minimum (see 2019 Swim Guide for exceptions). Nonconforming times may be submitted and will be used for seeding purposes only.

AWARDS: INDIVIDUAL EVENTS RIBBONS 1st through 8th

RIBBONS 1st through 3rd

Ribbons will be awarded to the following age groups: 5/6, 7/8, 9/10, 11/12

**ENTRY FEES:** \$4.00 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, plus \$10.00 SURCHARGE per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card. Relays \$10.00. 0E-Mail entry (entry.zipfile) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5PM postmark would queue before a 10 PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE.

Do not resend an entry file. A

REPLACEMENT FILE FOR THE TEAM WILL not BE PROCESSED. Deletions will NOT be refunded.

ENTRIES CLOSE: ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26, 2019. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO

THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED). To avoid any concern regarding receipt of entry card at the designated address, you are advised to enclose a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope for return when your entry is received.
