POOL ADDRESS: 101 S. Pavilion Center Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89144

DIRECTIONS: Pavilion Center Drive, off Charleston Blvd. Next to Palo Verde High School

Pool Dimensions: Indoor 8 lane 50m course, 7 lanes designated for competition, one outside lane + additional space for warm-up/warm-down. 8 lanes may be used for competition depending on number of entries. 4 side lanes will still be available for warm-up/warm-down. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.3.2(C) on file with USA Swimming.

Pool depth: start end 13.8 feet, turn end 4.6 feet.

MEDICAL SUPERVISION: Certified lifeguards provided by the facility will be available at this meet (Article 202.4.11.N)

WARM-UP Procedures: All lanes will be open for USA Swimming Member Coach supervised warm-up on Friday, Saturday, Sunday. *Depending on number of entries, warmup session may be split. Saturday and Sunday AM warmup session will move to begin at 7:15am in this case.* Team warmup lanes will be assigned and announced the week of the meet. Diving will be allowed in designated dive lanes only under the supervision of the coaches and marshals. The pool will close 10 minutes before the start of each session. All swimmers must use 3-point, slide in entries into the pool during warm up, no jumping or diving.

MEET REFEREE: Ryan McCarthy will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to the meet referee, email: rpm2@aol.com

RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern this meet. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. **This meet will limit entries to meet the "4 Hour" rule for 12-Under swimmers. All events will be PRE-SEDED. Scratches must be submitted no later than 5pm the evening before the events (i.e. 5pm Friday for Saturday events).** All events are timed finals. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on the first day of the meet. Swimmers must be at least 5 years old on May 22, 2026 to enter this meet. Athletes 11 and over may enter Senior events. **Swimmers may only swim one session per day and cannot swim the same event multiple times during the meet.** Timers are requested to be provided by each team. Swimmers in Friday's events 1-10 must provide their own timers and counter. Events will be swum fastest to slowest. **Swimmer may swim a maximum of 4 events per day. All coaches and officials on deck must complete CDC or NFHS Concussion course and must complete the CANRA Mandatory Reporting Course prior to the start of the meet. All persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be coach member of USA Swimming.**

RECORDING DEVICES & MEDIA NOTICE: The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. **Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet.** This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with AQUA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Tech suits with bonded seams, kinetic tape, or meshed seams are not allowed for 12&under swimmers. Please see the Tech Suit Policy on the SCS website: www.socalswim.org

DECK CHANGES: Deck Changes are prohibited.

RACING START CERTIFICATION: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

DISABILITY: Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any reasonable accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants, and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing (through email), accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to athletes who hold 2026 USA Swimming Registration. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to meet entry deadline. No late or deck registration will be accepted. Outside of Desert Committee and Outside of LSC entries will be accepted space available and must be pre-approved. Please reach out to Meet Director (alanadawidian@gmail.com) to reserve space. **All athletes 18 years or older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING (APT) prior to the start of the meet in order to compete.** No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

CHANGE OF AFFILIATION: Club Transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached, but is responsible to complete the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.

SUBMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be the **best recorded times** short course or long course from this or the preceding swim season (**NO WORK OUT TIMES**). For seeding purposes only, after entries close Meet Administration may convert non-conforming times. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Discrepancies in submitted times could lead to disciplinary action.

AWARDS: 1st – 3rd medals, 4th – 16th ribbons given to Boys/Girls in the following age groups: 5-8, 7-10, 11-12, 1st-3rd medals; 4th-8th ribbons given to 13-14 Boys/Girls; No awards for Senior Events. No awards for 15 & Over Events.

ENTRY FEES: \$6.00 for each individual event along with a \$15.00 surcharge per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card. **Outreach athletes are \$15 flat fee for the whole meet.** Teams must provide proof of outreach athlete status by including a copy of their team roster when

submitting entries. NO REFUNDS. Returned checks will incur a service fee. E-mail entry (entry. zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached .PDF file **including electronic signature** of coach and will be dated as official at that time. Full payment (single team check) is due at the admin desk before warmup of the 1st session in which the team is competing. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Team entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the meet processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (including e-mail) ONLY. Prior to entry deadline new swimmers are accepted SPACE PERMITTING. **DO NOT RE-SEND AN ENTRY FILE.** A replacement file for the team will not be processed. **Deletions will not be refunded.**

ENTRIES CLOSE: ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5PM, WEDNESDAY May 13, 2026. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED).

USA SWIMMING MEET 360:

Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming membership

During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming membership (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted.

Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands.

Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also be made to USA Swimming.

A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate in this competition.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in conduct of this competition.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy govern this meet.

Notes/ Rules:

- ^Use 7-10 200Free time to enter 400Free (Nat B time standard)
- Must be at least 11 years old to compete in Senior events
- Swimmers can swim only one session per day
- *Events 7-10 (Senior 800Free and 1500Free) will be swum
 - fastest to slowest,
 - alternating Girls/Boys and alternating 2 heats of 800, 2 heats of 1500
 - i.e. Heat 1 Girls 800; Heat 2 Boys 800; Heat 3 Girls 1500; Heat 4 Boys 1500
 - Swimmers provide their own timer and counter.
- Swimmers must meet listed time standard.
- Swimmers may not compete in the same event more than once (in multiple age groups and/or on multiple days)
- 8&under swimmers may compete in 5-8 and 7-10 events in any combination, but they may not swim the same event multiple times over the course of the meet
