WARM UP TIME: 7:30 AM (Fri/Sat/Sun)
MEET START TIME: 9:00 AM (Fri/Sat/Sun)

POOL: MARGUERITE RECREATION CENTER, 27474 Casta Del Sol, Mission Viejo, CA 92692.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-5 to the La Paz exit. Turn east on La Paz, left on Marguerite, and right on Casta Del Sol. Turn right at the first driveway. The swim parking lot is behind the tennis courts on the right with the exit being at the upper level. There is no RV parking in the swim parking lot.

COURSE: The LOWER MARGUERITE AQUATIC COMPLEX POOL is an outdoor, 50 meter x 25 yard pool with up to two 8 lane, 25 yard courses. Separate warm up pool available. Both competition courses have been certified in accordance with 104.22.2 (C). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. Pool Depth Measurement at South End = 2M; and North End = 3.5M. One or two courses may be used for PRELIMS. **The FINALS sessions will be run in a single 10 lane course.**

WARM UP PROCEDURES: USA Swimming warm-up policies will be enforced by USA Swimming Officials. Swimmers warming up or down before, during, after this swim meet must be under the direct supervision of an USA Swimming member coach. There will be NO DIVING into the pool during these times except into the designated sprint lane(s). **All swimmers must use 3-point, slide in entries into the pool during warm up, no jumping or diving.** WARM-UP RULES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND POSTED.

REFEREE: The meet referee shall be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be made directly to Jason Rothlein, e-mail: jtrothlein@gmail.com

MEET START TIMES: Preliminaries will begin at 9 AM. Warmups for FINALS sessions will begin no sooner than 2 hours after the completion of the final heat of the preliminary session.

DISTANCE EVENTS: The 500, 1000, 1650 Freestyle and 400 IM events are "timed finals" with standard seeding procedures. Events MAY be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee, and will be swum fastest to slowest.

Swimmers in the 500, 1000, 1650 Freestyle and 400 IM must positive check for the event, with the check-in deadline to be one hour before the event is to be swum.

Swimmers in the 500 Free, 1000 Free, 1650 Free and 400 IM should provide timers for 3 heats. You should provide your own lap counters. The 500 Free, 1000 Free, 1650 Free, and 400 IM will be seeded and swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.

EVENT A swimmer may swim a **MAXIMUM of THREE (3)** individual events per day (including time trials) and **TWO (2) relays**

COMBINED EVENTS:

Events may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

FINALS:

FINALS for the 5-9/10 will have a single, 10 lane Championship final for 5-9, followed by a Championship final for the 10 year olds. FINALS for the 11/12 events will have a single, 10 lane Championship final for the 11 year olds, followed by a Championship final for the 12 year olds. FINALS for the 13/14 events will have a single, 10 lane Championship final for the 13 year olds, followed by a Championship final for the 14 year olds. FINALS for the 15-Up events will have two, 10 lane finals heats for 15-Up, a Consol final (15-Up) followed by a Championship final (15-Up).

The 500 Free, 1000 Free, 1650 Free are TIMED FINALS. All heats of the 500 Free, 1000 Free, and 1650 Free events will be swum, fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys immediately following the preliminary session daily.

The 400 IM is a TIMED FINAL. All heats of the 400 IM EXCEPT the fastest heat (combined age groups) will be swum immediately following the preliminary session daily. The fastest heat of 400 GIRLS and 400 BOYS (combined age groups) will be swum in FINALS. Swimmers can declare AM or PM at check-in. All preliminary heats of the 400 IM will be swim fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.

All RELAYS are TIMED FINALS. All relays will be swum as part of the FINALS session, except that if time permits on Sunday (last day of the meet, relays may opt to swim at the end of PRELIMS).

The National finals scratch rule will be used.

A swimmer must scratch or place intent on an event within 30 minutes of announcement of preliminary results. A finals "no-show" (original top 10 places for 5-9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and original 20 places for 15-Up will be removed from the remainder of the meet. A swimmer missing his/her last finals event of the meet will be fined \$50 due payable to SCS before his/her next SCS competition.

RULES:

USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS Meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. (See 2025 SCS Swim Guide). Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. **THE FIRST FOUR EVENTS OF EACH SESSION WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THAT SESSION.** After an event has been officially closed, swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group determined by their age on February 14, 2025.

All coaches and officials on deck must be current USA Swimming members, and must have completed the CDC or NFHS Concussion online course. Coaches and officials on deck must have completed the CANRA certification.

Timers must be provided by each team.

ALL PRELIM and TIMED FINAL events will be seeded and swum fastest to slowest.

DISABILITY:

Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any reasonable accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants, and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing (email), accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests.

RECORDING DEVICES &

MEDIA NOTICE:

The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgment and consent to this fact.

DRONES:

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present

SWIMWEAR:

Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Tech suits with bonded seams, kinetic tape, or meshed seams are not permitted at this meet for 12-Under swimmers.

DECK CHANGES: Deck changes are prohibited.

RACING START CERTIFICATION:

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY:

OPEN TO ATHLETES who hold 2025 USA Swimming Registration. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. No late or deck registration will be accepted.

All athletes 18 years and older must complete the free online APT (ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING) course prior to the start of the meet to be cleared to compete

CHANGE OF AFFILIATION: Club Transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached, but is responsible to complete the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.

SUBMITTED TIMES: Submit ACTUAL times achieved for each event. If Standard is achieved in **LONG COURSE METERS**, enter event with **LCM time**, indicated on entry by "L". If Standard is achieved in **SHORT COURSE YARDS**, enter event with **SHORT COURSE YARD** time, indicated on entry by "Y".

If using an entry card, time on front of card must be clearly marked with either "L" or "Y". If entering electronically, "L" or "Y" must be indicated on proof of time sheet. (See 2025 SCS Swim Guide or www.socalswim.org for LCM, SCY, and/or SCM time standards) Time standards must have been achieved on or after Sept.1, 2023, and must be verifiable. Meets outside SCS or non USA Swimming meets are provable only with official results subject to SCS approval. (Refer to 2025 SCS Swim Guide.)

As a reminder: No updated times will be accepted after the meet entry deadline

ENTRIES: Entries must be made on Southern California Swimming Entry form or by electronic entry. **ELECTRONIC ENTRY IS PREFERRED.** E-mail entry (entry.zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or *.pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10 PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted only if SPACE is AVAILABLE. DO NOT RE-SEND AN ENTRY FILE. A replacement file for the team will NOT be processed. Deletions will NOT be refunded.

RELAYS: All relays must be pre-entered. Top 10 relays per event seeded by time will be in the FINALS session; all others will be swum after prelims and before distance, on a daily basis. **On Monday, there is an option to choose AM or PM relays for all relays. All relay swimmers must be entered in at least one qualifying event in the meet.**

ENTRY FEE: \$6.00 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, \$10.00 for each RELAY plus \$15.50 SURCHARGE per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card. **Coaches entering any qualified Outreach athletes in this meet, must notify the Meet Admin when sending their team entry report and file, listing the athletes name. The Outreach athlete entry fee is a \$15.00 flat fee.**

RETURNED CHECKS WILL INCUR A SERVICE FEE PER SCS POLICY. Entries will be rejected if a check does not accompany the entry card. Please put your swimmer's name and USA Swimming number on your check! E-mail entry (entry.zipfile) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of a coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10 PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. Do not re-send an entry file. A REPLACEMENT FILE FOR THE TEAM WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. Deletions will NOT be refunded.

ENTRIES DUE: **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2025. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED).** To avoid any concern regarding receipt of entry card at the designated address, you are advised to enclose a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope for return when your entry is received.

NO certified, registered or special delivery mail will be accepted.

USA SWIMMING MEET 360:

Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming membership

During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming membership (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted.

Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands.

Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also be made to USA Swimming.

A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate in this competition.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

TIME TRIALS: Sanction #S25-022

Will be swum time permitting. 3 events per day limit applies (Meet events + Time Trials = 3 events per day or less). Deck entered. Entry fee is \$20.00 per event, no refunds after seeding. Open only to 2025 USA Swimming registered swimmers who are entered in at least one individual event or relay. The Administrative Referee will determine the order of events.
