IMPERIAL HIGHWAY, ANAHEIM, CA. East on 91 Freeway towards Riverside, exit Imperial Highway, go right about 1/2 mile, Canyon High School is on the left side of the street. From the South: North on 55 Fwy, East on 91 Fwy, follow above. COURSE: CANYON HIGH SCHOOL pool is an outdoor 25 Yard pool with eight (8) swimming lanes and a warm up area. This competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C) on file with USA Swimming. Pool Depth Measurements at Start End Lane 1 = 6.1' to Lane 8 = 4.8', Turn End Lane 1 = 11.7' to Lane 8 = 4.7'. WARM UP RULES: USA Swimming warm-up policies will be enforced by USA Swimming Officials. Swimmers warming up or down before, during, or after this swim meet must be under the direct supervision of an USA Swimming member coach. There will be **NO DIVING** into the pool during these times except into the designated sprint lane(s). WARM-UP RULES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AND POSTED. All swimmers must use 3-point, slide in entries into the pool for warm up, no jumping or diving in. MEET REFEREE: Jason Rothlein shall be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be made directly to jtrothlein@gmail.com RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS Meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. (See 2024 SCS Swim Guide). Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed, swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers in the first four events of each session must check in **THIRTY MINUTES** prior to the start of their respective session. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on February 24, 2024. All Coaches and Officials on deck must complete the CDC or NFHS Concussion course, CAT and CANRA. Meet Check-in may or may not be available depending on the site's guidelines. Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP 2.0) will govern this meet. SPECIAL NOTICE: SWIMMERS MAY SWIM A MAXIMUM OF FOUR (4) EVENTS PER DAY. AAA will limit entries to meet the "4 Hour" rule for each session. Each team is asked to provide timers. Relays will be swum, time permitting. 13 & Up swimmers entering 50's of stroke must enter event with 100 of stroke time. 7/8 year old swimmers may only swim an event once even if it is offered twice. ALL EVENTS WILL BE SWUM FASTEST TO SLOWEST. High School swimmers are responsible for making sure they are unattached at this meet. RECORDING DEVICES The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not & MEDIA NOTICE: permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact. DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas are open ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. "Tech" suits are not permitted at this meet FOR 12 & UNDER SWIMMERS. DECK CHANGES: Deck Changes are prohibited. RACING START Any swimmer entered in the meet unaccompanied by a USA Swimming Coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in CERTIFICATION: performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. ELIGIBILITY: OPEN TO ATHLETES WHO ARE 2024 USA Swimming REGISTERED. SCS Athletes must be members of the Orange Committee to be eligible for entry into this meet. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. No late or deck registration will be accepted. In order to compete, all athletes 18 or older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING within 30 days of turning 18. CHANGE OF Club Transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached but is responsible for AFFILIATION: completing the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0. Times submitted must be BEST RECORDED TIMES short course or long course from this or preceding swim season (NO WORK OUT TIMES). After entries SUBMITTED TIMES: close, meet admin will convert non-conforming times for seeding purposes only. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Discrepancy in the submitted times can lead to disciplinary action. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time but is otherwise qualified, he/she may enter the meet at the minimum standard for an event (see 2024 Swim Guide QUALIFYING TIMES: for exceptions). After entries close, non-conforming times will be converted by meet admin for seeding purposes only AWARDS: RIBBONS 1 - 8 will be awarded to 5/6, 7/8, 7-10, 11/12, 13 & Up ENTRY FEE: \$6.00 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, plus \$15.00 SURCHARGE per swimmer must accompany each individual entry car. \$10.00 per Deck Entered Relay. E-mail entry (entry.zipfile) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Coaches entering any qualified Outreach athletes in this meet, must provide their team outreach registration roster from SWIMS/USA Swimming to the Meet Admin, when sending their team entry report and file, listing the outreach athletes' name. The Outreach athlete entry fee is a \$15.00 flat fee. DISABILITY: Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any reasonable accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants, and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing(email), accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests. ENTRIES CLOSE: ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2024. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED). To avoid any concern regarding receipt of entry card at the designated address, you are advised to enclose a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope for return when your entry is received. NO CERTIFIED, REGISTERED OR SPECIAL DELIVERY MAIL WILL BE ACCEPTED. PLEASE MAIL IN A BUSINESS SIZE ENVELOPE. DO NOT FOLD "White" ENTRY CARD---PLEASE.
