<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: From I 93-95 exit Horizon Ridge over the Freeway. Continuing past Boulder Highway as Horizon becomes Racetrack Road, the Heritage Park Aquatics Center will be on your left between New Port Drive and Burkholder Boulevard.

PARKING: Vehicles must be parked in a legal spot in one of the following parking lots: Aquatic Center Main, Aquatic Center Overflow, Sports Fields Main, or Senior Center Overflow. Parking in the Senior Center Main parking lot is strictly prohibited and vehicles will be subject to tow. See map at end of this meet form for designated parking and tent areas.

<u>WARM-UP PROCEDURES</u>: All lanes will be open for USA Swimming Member Coach supervised assigned warm-up between 6:30-8:15 am Saturday, Sunday, Monday and 7 am on Tuesday. All swimmers must use 3- point, slide in entries into the pool during warm up, no jumping or diving. Diving will be allowed in designated dive lanes only under the supervision of the coaches and marshals. Dive lanes will be assigned. Dive lanes will open 30-45 minutes before the start of each session at the discretion of the meet referee. The pool will close 15 minutes before the start of each session. <u>Warm – Up sessions may be split, and lanes assigned depending on entries</u>.

RULES: Usa Swimming rules will govern this meet. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on the first day of the meet. Age groups awarded as follows 5-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-up. Swimmers must be at least 5 years old on November 8, 2025, to enter this meet. Timers are requested to be provided by each team. All coaches and officials on deck must complete the CDC or NFHS Concussion course and must complete the CANRA Mandatory Reporting course prior to the start of the meet. All persons acting in any coaching capacity in a sanctioned event must be a coach member of USA Swimming.

One coach per team will receive a packet with printouts of all the athletes entered, divided up by day Coaches will use this list to indicate any scratches from that day

All prelim events will be swum slow to fast. Timed final events will be swum slow to fast. Finals will be swum from slow to fast. Finals for 11-12, 13-14 will be B and A. 15 and over will be C, B and A finals. National Championship finals scratch rule will be in effect

<u>Prelims</u> - The national finals' scratch rule will be used for Prelims. The scratch deadline is 30 minutes after announcement of qualifiers. Per SCS swim Guide p.58, II.B.4, In **timed finals and Prelim events**, failure to report to the blocks ("no show") after checking in, will result in disqualification from that event

<u>Finals Scratches</u> - A swimmer/or coach must scratch or declare their intent on an event within 30 minutes of announcement of preliminary results for Finals. Final "no-show" (original top places only) except last day will be removed from the remainder of the meet. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed to the swimmer for a no show at her/his last event of the meet.

<u>Scratches</u> – Admin will accept scratches until 30 minutes after announcement. If the swimmer is not scratched and they then Declare a False Start the next day, it COUNTS, as an Event. (Which counts toward the 7-event limit).

<u>Relays</u> – PRELIM/FINALS – Relay cards MUST be turned back in by the end of prelims for Finals Relays. **Relay changes:** Relay changes or scratches are due by the end of Prelims for those swimming in Finals. **Relay-Only Swimmer** changes need to be brought to Admin by the due date/time of that relay.



<u>If there is an admin error:</u> The swimmer will NOT be penalized by swimming exhibition and may advance to finals. Time allowing - Re-seed, split heat or open lane.

Calling for a missing swimmer in:

PRELIMS – Heat and lane will be called, **ONCE**. (No swimmer's name) **FINALS** – If the swimmer is not at the lane, the alternate will be called. Once the alternate is called, the <u>original swimmer is considered to be a no show.</u> (Finals penalty for No Show is removal from reminder of meet)

Swimmers competing in the 1650 freestyle (events 141-142) are requested to furnish timers for three heats and lap counters. 1650 will combine age groups, alternting girls/boys. Tuesday, 11-12 500 Free will be swum slowest to fastest. 400 IM and 1650 will be swum fastest to slowest.

5-8 or 9-10 age group swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 events per day 7 total for the meet plus relays. 11 and over age group swimmers may swim a maximum of 3 events per day 7 total for the meet plus relays.

Relays may be submitted electronically with individual entry or deck entered by the announced time on Saturday & Sunday. Relay cards will be available during the meet at the Admin table. All relay swimmers must be entered in an individual event in the meet or the name(s) of all relay only swimmer(s) must be submitted with the team entries with the participation fee. 11 & Over swimmers may compete in the Open relays or in relays for their age division, **BUT NOT BOTH.** Relays will be swum in Finals sessions.

SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with AQUA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Tech suits are permitted at this meet for 13 and over swimmers. **12 & under swimmers are not permitted to use tech suits.** Please see SCS Tech Suit Policy on SCS website www.socalswim.org.

DECK CHANGING: Deck Changes are prohibited.

RACING START CERTIFICATION: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all State of Nevada athletes who hold 2025-2026 USA Swimming Registration. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. **NO** late or deck registration will be accepted. All athletes 18 and older must complete the free online Athlete Protection Training (APT) prior to the meet in order to compete. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations

<u>DISABILITY:</u> Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any reasonable accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants, and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing (email), accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests.

<u>CHANGE OF AFFILIATION:</u> Club transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached but is responsible for completing the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.

SUBMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be the **best recorded times** short course or long course from this season or proceeding swim seasons **(NO WORK OUT TIMES)**. All nonconforming times may be converted by the meet processor. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Discrepancies in submitted times could lead to disciplinary action.

<u>Bonus Events:</u> Swimmers with 1 qualifying time standard may enter up to 2 additional Bonus Events where the bonus standard is achieved. Swimmers with 2 qualifying times may enter 1 additional Bonus Event where the bonus standard is achieved.

<u>SWIMMERS WITH 3 OR MORE</u> <u>QUALIFYING TIMES, NO BONUS EVENTS.</u> Bonus time standards for events distance 25 add .25 sec, 50 add .50 sec, 100 add 1.00 sec, and 200 add 2.00 sec to the qualifying time standards for those events. There are no bonus events for distances longer than 200. Short course meter swims should be converted to short course yards.

AWARDS: Individual events Medals 1-10, ribbons 11-20.

Individual High Point and Runner Up (5-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 and 15-up)

Relavs Medals 1-3

ENTRY FEES: \$7.00 for each individual event along with a \$20.00 surcharge Plus \$10 Facility Charge per swimmer must accompany each individual entry. NO REFUNDS. Relays \$20.00 per relay. Relay only swimmers fee is \$30.00. Outreach athletes are \$15.00 flat fee for the meet. Teams must provide proof of outreach athlete status by including a copy of their team roster when submitting entries. Returned checks will incur a service fee. E-mail entry (entry. zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached .PDF file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time (5PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Team Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE. A replacement file for the team will not be processed. Deletions will not be refunded. If entering individually, emailed or texted entries are not accepted. Please enter using the SCS Individual Meet Entry Form. Entries are accepted, SPACE PERMITTING, when the entry is received TOGETHER with a check, money order or cash, by the meet processor.

<u>ENTRIES CLOSE</u>: ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, Wednesday, October 29,2025. To avoid concern regarding receipt of entry card at the designated address, enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope or postcard (*Receipt of entries will not be verified by phone or e-mail.*).

<u>DRONES:</u> Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

RECORDING DEVICES AND MEDIA NOTICE: The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms or obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

NO FOOD ALLOWED ON DECK. WATER AND GATORADE ARE PERMITTED.

FOOD IS PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE COMPETITION POOL AREA.

TEMPORARY STRUCTURE - 5-FT. OPEN ENTRY POLICY SCS policy 6/2019

At all USA Swimming sanctioned events held in Southern California Swimming, any temporary structure cannot be fully enclosed without a minimum 5-foot open entry or clear windows with an accessible 5-foot entry. Temporary structures are tents, canopies and tarps.

Canopy space will be provided outside the pool and families and teams are requested to make their base in the canopy area and leave pool side space for temporarily watching specific races.

No Deck Chairs are allowed on the pool deck except for Coaches in the Coaches seating area.

Deck chairs will be allowed outside on patios and in the tented areas.

There will be a Hospitality area provided for Coaches and Officials during the meet.

USA SWIMMING MEET 360:

Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming membership

During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming memberhsip (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted.

Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands.

Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also be made to USA Swimming.

A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate in this competition.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy 3.0 (MAAPP 3.0) govern this meet.



Parking in the (5) Senior Center Main parking lot or designated no parking areas is **strictly prohibited** and vehicles will be subject to tow. RVs parked in lots 1, 2, & 4 must fit in a single space; larger RVs should park in lot 3.



Setup Information

No deck chairs will be allowed on the pool deck. Pool side seating will be available for temporarily watching races.
