Directions: 14 FWY N Take Golden Valley exit left to Centre Pointe Parkway. 14 FWY S Take Golden Valley exit right to Centre Pointe Parkway.

Course: Outdoor 50 meter x 25 yard with up to 10 competition lanes and 10 warm up warm down lanes. OR POSSIBLY TWO COURSES UP TO 8 COMPETITION LANES The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C) on file with USA Swimming. POOL DEPTH: Start end 7'6". Turn end 7'6".

Ample deck space is available for canopies and seating. The areas behind the starting blocks and coaches tables will be limited to athletes, coaches, officials, and timers. Bring tie-downs and weights to secure your canopies.

Warm-Up Procedures: All lanes will be open for warm-up under the direct supervision of a current 2026 or 2027 USA Swimming member coach from either 6:30 to 7:50 AM OR 7:30 to 8:50 AM. Official warm up times will depend on the number of entries, and will be announced when the estimated timeline is released. Warm-up rules will be announced and enforced. All swimmers must use 3-point slide entry into the pool during warm-up, no jumping or diving except for the sprint lanes directed by the Meet Referee; dive lanes will open upon request. Marshals will be designated to oversee the warm-up procedure and pool.

Rules: USA Swimming rules will govern this meet. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. This meet will limit entries to meet the "4 hour rule" for 12-Under swimmers, unless a Championship meet. The 11-12 age group may move to their own session to accommodate entries and meet the "4 hour rule".

Swimmers must check in with the clerk of course 30 minutes prior to the start of each session for the 4 events of that session. After the event has been officially closed, SWIMMERS MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers must swim in their actual age group as determined by the age on the first day of the meet (October 10, 2026).

Swimmers must be at least 5 years old on the start date of the meet to enter. Timers are required to be provided by each team. **Swimmers competing in the following events (1000 Freestyle and 500 Freestyle) are requested to provide their own timers and provide lap counters.**

Events will be swum fastest to slowest. Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events per day.

All coaches and officials on deck must complete the CDC or NFHS Concussion course and must be in current good standing with USA Swimming in order to perform coaching duties at the meet. All coaches and officials on deck must complete the CANRA Mandatory Reporting course. All athletes 18 years & older must complete the free, online Athlete Protection Training prior to the meet in order to compete: www.usaswimming.org/apt

Recording Devices and Media Notice: The uses of audio visual recording devices, including cell phones, are NOT permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, webcasting and other

forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

- Drones:** Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
- Swimwear:** Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with AQUA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Tech suits are NOT permitted at this meet for 12-Under swimmers. Please see the Tech Suit Policy on the SCS website: www.socalswim.org
- Deck Changes:** Deck changes are prohibited.
- Racing Start Certification:** Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Disability:** Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any reasonable accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants, and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing (email), accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host's ability to accommodate all requests.
- Eligibility:** Open to Coastal Committee teams, athletes, and teams outside the LSC who hold 2026 or 2027 USA Swimming registration. Out of LSC teams will be accepted after Coastal teams entries who are received by deadline. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. No late or deck registration will be accepted. Out-of-LSC entries will be accepted, space available; please submit a copy of registration with entry. All athletes 18 years or older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING (APT) prior to the start of the meet in order to compete. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.
- Change of Affiliation:** Club Transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached, but is responsible to complete the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.
- Submitted Times:** Times submitted must be the best recorded times short course or long course from this or preceding swim season (NO WORK OUT TIMES). For seeding purposes only, after entries close, Meet Administration may convert non-conforming times. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Discrepancies in submitted times could lead to disciplinary action.
- Entry Fees:** \$6.00 for each individual event, plus a \$15.50 surcharge per swimmer. Outreach athletes are \$15.00 flat fee for the meet. Teams must provide proof of outreach athlete status by including a copy of their team roster when submitting entries.

Entry fees must accompany each individual entry. NO REFUNDS. Returned checks will incur a service fee per SCS policy.

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by the meet processor NO LATER THAN 5:00 PM WEDNESDAY, September 30th, 2026. If the meet fills to the "4 Hour Rule" prior to the deadline, entries will be rejected (last received, first rejected).

Entry Submissions: To avoid concern regarding receipt of entry at the designated address, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard. Receipt of entries will NOT be verified by phone, email or text message. E-mailed team entry (entry .zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received together with an attached PDF file, including electronic signature of coach, and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10 PM electronic entry, etc.). Full payment (SINGLE TEAM CHECK) for an e-mailed zip file entry must be

postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mailed zip file entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Team entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the meet processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (including e-mail) ONLY. Prior to entry deadline new swimmers are accepted SPACE PERMITTING. Deletions will not be refunded.

If entering individually, emailed or texted entries are not accepted. Please enter using the SCS Individual Meet Entry Form. Entries are accepted, SPACE PERMITTING, when the entry is received TOGETHER with a check, money order or cash, by the meet processor.

USA SWIMMING MEET 360:

Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming membership

During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming membership (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted.

Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands.

Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also be made to USA Swimming.

A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate in this competition.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-5US-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.
