NOVICE SESSION: Sat. 2:00 pm

DIRECTIONS: From HWY 101 South, take the Orcutt exit to HWY 135. Exit HWY 1-Lompoc to "H" street. West at College Ave. Turn North past the YMCA and drive to the Lompoc Aquatic Center. HWY 101 North, Next to HWY 1Lompoc, one-mile past Gaviota Park. Turn West to Ocean Ave. Turn North to "H" street. Turn West to College Ave. Turn North past the YMCA and drive to the Lompoc Aquatic Center. Overflow parking is West of the Lompoc Aquatic Center at Lompoc High School.

COURSE: Indoor 25 yd. x 85-foot pool with 10 competition lanes and 4 warm-up lanes. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C). Pool depth: start end 7' to 9', turn end 7' to 9'.

WARM-UP Procedures: All lanes will be open for USA Swimming Member Coach supervised warm-up between 7:30 – 8:55 AM Saturday and Sunday for Age Group Sessions and 1:30-1:55 PM Saturday for the Novice Session. All swimmers must use a 3- point slide in entry into the pool for warm up/warm down, no jumping or diving. Diving will be allowed in designated dive lanes only under the supervision of the coaches and marshals. Dive lanes will be assigned. Dive lanes will open 45 minutes before the start of the meet. The pool will close 5 minutes before the start of each session.

MEET REFEREE: Will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to Ernie Peterson: ErnieP@kcienv.com

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP 2.0), will govern. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. This meet will limit entries to meet the "4 Hour" rule. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on the first day of the meet. Swimmers must be at least 5 years old on December 7, 2024 to enter this meet. Timers are requested to be provided by each team. Swimmers competing in the 500 & 1650 Free and 400 I.M. are requested to furnish their own timers for three heats and lap counters. Events will be swum fastest to slowest. Swimmer may swim a maximum of 4 events per day. All officials and coaches on deck must have completed the CDC or NFHS online Concussion course. All officials on deck must have completed the CANRA Mandatory Reporting course.

CHECK IN: Check-in will be via coach check-in. Coaches will be provided a list of their entries for each session and must indicate any scratches to the Admin Referee more than 30 minutes prior to the session starting. After the session has been closed, swimmers will be seeded into their events and not be able to scratch. There is no penalty for a "no-show" in an event.

RECORDING DEVICES & MEDIA NOTICE: The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet. This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgment and consent to this fact.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. Tech suits are not permitted at this meet for 12-Un swimmers; please see the Tech Suit Policy on the SCS website: <a href="https://www.socalswim.org">www.socalswim.org</a>.

DECK CHANGES: Deck Changes are prohibited.

Concussion Protocol: ALL COACHES AND OFFICIALS MUST COMPLETE THE CDC OR NFHS CONCUSSION ONLINE COURSE.

Concussion Informed Consent Acknowledgment Any swimmer under the age of 18 entered in the meet must have a current (within the year), athlete and parent signed Concussion Informed Consent Acknowledgment. If affiliated with a member club, it must be on file with the club. If unaffiliated with a member club, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's parent or legal guardian to ensure

RACING START CERTIFICATION: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to Coastal Committee athletes who hold 2024 or 2025 USA Swimming Registration. Online registration in SWIMS 3.0 must be completed prior to the meet entry deadline. No late or deck registration will be accepted. All athletes 18 years or older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING (APT) prior to the start of the meet in order to compete. Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Prevention Policy 2.0 (MAAPP 2.0) will govern this meet.

CHANGE OF AFFILIATION: Club transfers (unattach or attach) can only be completed online in SWIMS 3.0. At a meet, a swimmer may compete as Unattached, but is responsible to complete the Club Transfer process online in SWIMS 3.0.

SUBMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be the best recorded times short course or long course from this or the preceding swim season (NO WORK OUT TIMES). For seeding purposes only, after entries close Meet Administration will convert non-conforming times. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Discrepancies in submitted times could lead to disciplinary action.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st – 8th place, Novice: 8-Under, 9-10, 11-12 Age Group:10-Under, 11-12. All results and awards will be separated into Girls and Boys. Prizes will be awarded to heat winners. I

ENTRY FEES: \$6.00 for each individual event along with a \$15.50 surcharge per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card. The Outreach athlete entry fee is a \$15.00 flat fee. NO REFUNDS. Returned checks will incur a service fee. E-mail entry (entry. zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached .PDF file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time.

(SPM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. Prior to entry deadline new swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE. A replacement file for the team will not be processed. Deletions will not be refunded. ENTRIES CLOSE: ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, WEDNESDAY, November 22, 2023. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED). To avoid concern regarding receipt of entry card the designated address, enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope or postcard. (Receipt of entries will not be verified by phone or e-mail.)
