IMPORTANT FACTS OF THE MEET

POOL: SANTA CLARITA AQUATIC CENTER, 20850 CENTRE POINTE PARKWAY, SANTA CLARITA, CA 91350

DIRECTIONS: 14 FWY N Take Golden Valley exit left to Centre Pointe Parkway. 14 FWY S Take Golden Valley exit right to Centre Pointe Parkway.

<u>COURSE</u>: Outdoor 50 meter x 25 yard with 10 competition lanes **SCY** and 10 warm up warm down lanes. OR POSSIBLY TWO COURSES UP TO 8 COMPETITON LANES The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C) on file with USA Swimming. Pool depth: start end 7'6".

RULES: USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. (See 2023 SCS Swim Guide). **THE EVENTS OF EACH SESSION WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THAT SESSION.** After the event has been officially closed, SWIMMERS MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by their age on the first day of the meet. Swimmer must be at least 5 years old on February 17th, 2024. All coaches and officials on deck must be current USA Swimming members, and must have completed the CDC or NFHS Concussion online course.

Coaches and officials on deck must have completed the CANRA certification. Maximum THREE events per day. (Not including finals).

- 11-12 & 13-14 category athletes have a choice to enter the 11-12 & 13-14 age bracket and swim only in Div II OR swim in the 11&Over bracket in Div I. In any instance, 11-12 & 13-14 can only swim in 1(one) session be it either Div I OR Div II. (*Note Div II 11-12 & 13-14 have different events then Division I session for the 11&Over bracket which will have options to swim the 200 of each stroke, Butterfly, Breaststroke and Backstroke.)
- Div I 11 & Over one hard cut gets 2 bonus swims per day.
- Meet will limit 700 swimmers, first come, first serve. The last teams entered may have to trim their roster to meet the limits of the meet. The meet admin does have the right to adjust timelines based upon entries.
- All preliminary heats will be circle seeded and swum fastest-to-slowest. All timed finals events will be seeded and swum fastest to slowest. The 500 Freestyle and 400 IM will be seeded and swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.
- Timers must be provided by each team.
- Swimmers in the 500 Freestyle should provide timers for three heats. Athletes should provide your own lap counters.
- The 500 free and 400IM is timed finals for the 11-12 age group. Swimmers only can swim 1(one) division.

GENERAL INFORMATION

MAAPP 2.0: Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP2.0"), will govern this meet. Per MAAPP 2.0, sites are supposed to be able to provide separate athlete/non athlete bathrooms.

<u>CHANGE OF AFFILIATION</u>: Before the meet, a swimmer may change affiliation by submitting a **Club Transfer form** to the Swim Office. At the meet, a swimmer may UNATTACH (may not attach or reattach) by notifying the Administrative Referee in writing and paying the appropriate fee.

WARM-UP Procedures: All lanes will be open for USA Swimming Member Coach supervised warm-up between 7:00 AM - 8:20 AM. Diving will be allowed in designated dive lanes only under the supervision of the coaches and marshals. Dive lanes will be assigned. Dive lanes will open 20 minutes before the start of the meet. The pool will close 10 minutes before the start of the meet. All swimmers must enter the pool using a three point entry. Warm-up rules will be announced and posted.

RACING START CERTIFICATION: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a membercoach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RECORDING DEVICES & MEDIA NOTICE: The use of audio-visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in locker rooms, changing areas or restrooms. **Recording devices are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the starting sequence throughout the meet.** This meet may be covered by the media, including photographs, video, web casting and other forms of obtaining images of athletes participating in the meet. Entry into the meet is acknowledgement and consent to this fact.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

SWIMWEAR: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specifications may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or approved competition. TECH WITH BONDED OR MESH SEAMS MAY BE WORN BY 13 AND OLDER. www.socalswim.org.

DECK CHANGES: Deck Changes are prohibited.

ENTERING THE MEET

ELIGIBILITY: Open to 2023 USA Swimming members. NO ON-DECK ENTIRES. Registration application **must be received by the meet entry deadline** by meet processor, administrative referee, or SCS Office. Late application will be considered "on-deck" subject to penalties in SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, B. Registration application may be submitted with entry form. In SCS age group meets, swimmers 18 & younger must prove birth dates prior to competition. **ALL athletes 18 years and older must complete the free online ATHLETE PROTECTION TRAINING course to be cleared to compete.**

SUBMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be the **best recorded times** short course or long course from this or the preceding swim season **(NO WORK OUT TIMES)**. For seeding purposes only, after entries close Meet Administration will convert non-conforming times. Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Swimmers must have achieved time standards listed for an event. Discrepancies in submitted times could lead to disciplinary action.

ENTRY FEES: \$6.00 for each INDIVIDUAL EVENT, \$10 for relays, plus \$15.00 surcharge per swimmer. NO REFUNDS. Returned checks will incur a service fee. E-mail entry (entry. zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached .PDF file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an email entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the email entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. Prior to entry deadline new swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE, DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE, A replacement file for the team will not be processed. Deletions will not be refunded. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE **REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED).** To avoid concern regarding receipt of entry card the designated address, enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope or postcard. (Receipt of entries will not be verified by phone or e-mail.) Coaches entering any qualified Outreach athletes in this meet, must notify the Meet Admin when sending their team entry report and file, listing the athletes name. The Outreach athlete entry fee is \$15.00 flat fee.

CHAMPIONSHIP PROCEDURES

FINALS: A championship final, 10 swimmers (1-10) will be offered for 7-10, 11-12, 13-14. 15&Over age groups will be top 20 with a consolation heat and final heat. 15&Over the top 20 will all come from Division I. 11-12 and 13-14 the top 10 will be made up from top 8 in Division I plus top 2 in Division 2 with the exception of the 200 Fly, 200 Back, 200 Breast which will all come from the Division I. The 50's of strokes Top 10 will come from Division II For 11-12. Top 10 swimmers from Division II in the 7-10 age group make finals.

EXCEPTIONS:

If the 11-12, 13-14 event in Division 1 is not contested in Division 2, then the top 10 field will come from Division 1 *In the event that the 11/12 and 13/14 Division 1 does not produce a top 8 the top 10 will then come from a combined overall top 10 from Division 1 and Division II in the respective overlapping events.

The national finals' scratch rule will be used.

SCRATCH FOR THE FINALS: A swimmer must scratch or place an intent on an event within 30 minutes of announcement of preliminary results. Final "no--show" (original top places only) except last day will be removed from the next event of the meet. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed to the swimmer for a no show in her/his last event of the meet.

AWARDS: MEDALS 1st- 8th, the following age groups will be awarded: 7-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over. Swag bags and goodies for all swimmers.

<u>RELAYS</u>: May be added based upon entries and timelines. Either to prelims or finals. 200 Freestyle, 200 Medley, 400 Freestyle, 400 Medley. Relays would be deck entered and due by the end of prelims.

It is understood and agreed that by committing to this event USA Swimming, Paseo Aquatics, Inc., Paseo Aquatics Sports LLC shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

LIFE SAFETY

Earthquake: Adhere to facility emergency procedures. Notify lifeguards. Notify all occupants to clear pool immediately. Call 911 if needed. Evacuate all persons in attendance to parking lot or front lawn away from all buildings. Contact all teams and request an accountability check.

Fires: Call 911. Clear the pool immediately. Evacuate all persons in attendance to parking lot or safe area outside of structure. Contact all teams and request an accountability check. Await emergency response outside structure and report to responding personnel if all persons are accounted for.

Hazardous Materials: Call 911. Notify lifeguards. Evacuate all persons in attendance to a safe area away from and upwind of any hazardous material.

Electrical Emergency: Call 911. Notify lifeguards. Notify all occupants to clear the pool immediately. Isolate the area of hazard and deny entry. Move all attendees to a safe area away from the hazard.
